Dear Mayor and Trustees,

You said two things were stopping you from continuing this fight:

1. A legal way forward to summary judgement and beyond.
2. Money to fund the lawyers to take this to summary judgement.

I think that the evidence shows that not only is there a clear legal path forward, there is a better chance of winning than most of us knew even last week. I won't list all the evidence here, but I find it extremely bizarre that our current lawyer is not recommending we continue to fight.

Regarding money to fund this fight, We have raised 30k in one week. The estimated cost has been 100k to take it to summary judgement. The estimated time is 18 months. We haven't even tapped into many neighbors, or considered possible tax assessments, and we already have 30k. All we need is 100k in 18 months. That number now seems almost too easy.

You have all made it clear that you don't want this cell tower, so it seems like the logical thing to do - knowing what we know now about money available and the legal path forward— would be to NOT SETTLE.
